Explanatory Note

Special Resolution to adopt an altered constitution

The constitution of PLSLSC was last updated in 2018. Considerable governance reform has occurred in Australia in the past decade leading to an increasing demand on Boards. This has led to governance becoming a bigger issue in the non-profit sector and led to heightened expectations for Not for Profit (NFP) boards, particularly those organisations without a CEO/General Manager, such as PLSLSC. A large proportion of our directors are volunteers who do not necessarily have business financial or directorship experience.

Directors of NFPs face similar legal liabilities as company directors, despite many being volunteers. A significant challenge for PLSLSC is for the Board (Executive Committee) to maintain an appropriate focus on governance while also providing the more hands-on role of running and managing the Club's operations. This has often led to a focus by the EC on management and tactical issues. This often distracts from the need to provide effective governance.

With a \$5.4 million dollar club house about to be completed; an evolving membership base; and a more complex stakeholder base that includes donors and funders, government agencies, consumer donations, interest groups and the community at large; the importance of good governance practice is becoming more important. As we move into a new stage of the Club's history, we risk not having appropriate skills, knowledge and experience to guide the organisation forward.

Proposed Organisational structure

The recommendation is that PLSLSC should move away from a 'Executive' and 'General' Committee structure and instead develop a small strategic and agile Board supported by operational sub-committees. The Board will focus on key areas of governance, risk and strategy.

The Board will be comprised of a minimum five elected officers, elected at the annual general meeting for a term of two years. It may also comprise of up to two additional non-executive directors as required from time-to-time.

The minimum elected directors are:

- 1. President
- 2. Secretary
- 3. Club Captain
- 4. Director (Programs)
- Treasurer

The supporting operational subcommittees will defined by charters and reporting to the Board. The key aspects of the charters will include:

- · Meet on a monthly basis;
- Submit area reports to the rest of the committee prior to the meeting;
- Record minutes of meetings; and
- Submit both the minutes of meetings and area reports to the board at the conclusion of each meeting.

The elected office holders, in addition to the Board will comprise "the Committee". The Committee will be governed by way of a charter established by the Board. It will meet at least twice annually, once prior to the season and once prior to the AGM. Further to the above, each of the committees will also appoint 'Officers' in supporting roles. A member will only be entitled to be appointed to a role where there is a requirement determined by the sub-committee and endorsed by the Board.

The Chair of the meeting intends to vote all available proxies **in favour** of the resolution.
